2010 Plans

Global Focus has plans to go to China, Montana, Panama, Africa and Lebanon this year. I know this year will be a great time of both equipping the saints of God to do the ministry and seeing the harvest of souls from their ministries. We want to combine training and outreach to maximize our efforts in these areas.

Beijing, China: Judy and Carl Comstock went to be a part of a gathering of leaders in business and ministry to see how we can reach the children of Asia. Many great connections were made and a huge burden was imparted for the country. We met with Gospel Light at CPC in San Diego as a follow up from this trip and have great plans for a possible Mini-CPC in Hong Kong, which would be a central location for all of Asia.

Crow Native American Reservation in Pryor, Montana: I visited the reservation last month and was able to meet Rev. Patrick Stands, who is the pastor of ArrowCreek Christian Center and former Tribal Chairman for the entire Crow Nation. This man is still very respected among the Crow. He and his son Russell will be our main contacts. We plan a Stateside endeavor here June 25-July 2 to work with several churches on the reservation to conduct VBS and teacher trainings along with community outreaches and family rallies, similar to what happened in the Chicago area. This will be a great family mission trip and we have had a great response from all over for this trip.

Panama City, Panama: During the INCM BoD meeting in September, I have been working with Benita Sanchez to develop a large teacher training during that time where myself along with the BoD members will conduct workshops and minister during the day and in evening rallies.

Beruit, Lebanon: Raja Achi from Gran De Ble (Grain of Wheat) host kid's camps throughout the year for the Muslim and Christian Children together. He relayed to me the need for training for the leaders of these camps and the possibility of us ministering at one. We are trying to make plans to couple this trip with the Global Children's Ministry Conference in September after the Board meeting.

Kampala/Lira, Uganda: In 2005, I was in Uganda working with Pastor Jimmy Odongo and Bethel Children's Ministry. They are reaching hundreds of children each week and many are AIDS orphans. I conducted a teacher training there and had hundreds of Children's leaders from all over. We will do the same along with feeding outreaches and large open air city-wide crusades. Projected time is November 10-17, 2010

CPC Missions Offering

We had a great time in both Nashville and San Diego during General Sessions 2 & 3 for Global Focus. Jeff Smith from Salt and Light did a fantastic job of leading the Rhythm Café. The prayers for the continents was powerful. We get requests or comments on almost a weekly basis about this presentation.

We collected \$12,000 in Nashville, My Children's Church collected \$1,530.00 and then in San Diego we collected \$5,200 for a total offering of **\$18,730**
